Current process and next steps

- Appraisal mission 2-weeks mission in Gaborone from February 17 to 28, 2020.
- Meetings and interviews:
 - SADC: FANR, ORGAN, PPRM, DRR, Infrastructure;
 - CCARDESA, MoF Botswana, MET Namibia, EU, KfW, DFID/BHC, FAO;
 - USAID/Resilient Waters, WFP/RVAA, SASSCAL,
 - ILRI, CIMMYT, PPF, CI, RSDA, South-South-North, SAWC, Hatfield Consultancy.
- Debriefing with representatives of FANR and CCARDESA and GIZ 27/02/2020.
- **Signing of the Agreed Minutes next week.**
- **Submission of project proposal to BMZ end of May 2020.**
- **Expected approval by BMZ in August 2020.**
- **Start January 2021, EUR 4 million, 3 years.**



Objective:

The mainstreaming of climate change in agriculture and cross-border management of natural resources in the SADC region is strengthened.

Indicator 1:

2 SADC strategies in NRM or agriculture (e.g. TFCAs Programme, Biodiversity Strategy) have mainstreamed climate change and are validated by SADC structures.



Output 1:

Strategic planning framework strengthened.

Indicator 2:

3 regional training institutions have integrated additional CSA and CSNRM contents into their training programmes.



Output 2:

Dissemination of knowledge CSA/CSNRM strengthened.

Indicator 3:

70% of 2.000 community members of TFCAs who participated in CSA and CSNRM activities confirm that their livelihood situation has improved (i.e. food security, income).



Output 3:

CSA/CSNRM implemented in selected TFCAs.

Output 1: The strategic planning framework for mainstreaming climate change into cross-border NRM is strengthened

Intervention level: Regional and TFCA level

Key activities:

- 1.1 Analyse current **status of TFCA implementation** (i.e. status, lessons learned etc.).
- 1.2 Elaborate **Implementation & Investment Plan (IIP)** and monitoring framework for the **TFCA Programme**.
- 1.3 Compile and disseminate **financing options and mechanisms** for TFCA funding including climate finance.
- 1.4 Analyse **climate risk and mitigation potential** in one TFCA and share methodology and results with TFCAs.
- 1.5 Support development of the post-2020 Regional **Biodiversity Strategy and Action Plan (RBSAP)** regarding climate change and TFCA integration.



Output 2: The dissemination of knowledge on CSA and CSNRM is strengthened.

Intervention level: Regional, TFCA level, Member States, individual partners

Key activities:

- 2.1 Identify and document relevant **good CSA and CSNRM practices** and training materials.
- 2.2 Strengthen the **dissemination** and uptake of good CSA/CSNRM practices through analogue and **digital** formats.
- 2.3 Identify existing **regional training institutions** and their training programmes.
- 2.4 Strengthen **knowledge exchange and cooperation** among regional training and applied research institutions regarding CSA and CSNRM.
- 2.5 Facilitate insertion of CSA and CSNRM contents into **training programmes**.



Output 3: CSA and CSNRM measures are implemented in selected TFCA's

Intervention level: Selected TFCAs / local level, Member States

Key activities:

- 3.1 Select **demonstration projects** for CSA and CSNRM based on agreed criteria (call for proposals in 2020).
- 3.2 Establish **vulnerability analysis** for demonstration projects.
- 3.3. **Develop** CSA and CSNRM approaches and **practices** with **women, men and young people** of local communities and other involved stakeholders and strengthen their technical and organizational capacities.
- 3.4 **Exchange** successful CSA and CSNRM practices between local communities and other relevant TFCA stakeholders.
- 3.5 **Showcase** demonstration projects as regional SADC integration models.



Potential implementing partners:

- TFCA Secretariats / Structures
- TFCA Network
- CCARDESA
- Applied research and development centres
- Regional training institutions/centres
- NGOs, community organisations
- Extension services



Output 3: Selection of demonstration sites

- Budget ca. 600.000 EUR, 2-3 projects with 100.000 to 300.000 EUR, duration 2 years
- Call for proposals in 2020
 - **Topics:** Climate-smart agriculture-NRM-fisheries, mitigating deforestation/REDD+, ecosystem-based adaptation, alternative livelihoods.
 - **Criteria**
 - ✓ Proven concept
 - ✓ Existing cross-border initiatives within SADC TFCA (ideally with MoU or Treaty level)
 - ✓ Co-funding capacity (In-kind or leveraging of funding)
 - ✓ Strong project implementer with track record (tech./fin. capacity, ability to **spend** cross-border)
 - ✓ Adaptation and mitigation
 - ✓ Women and youth involvement
